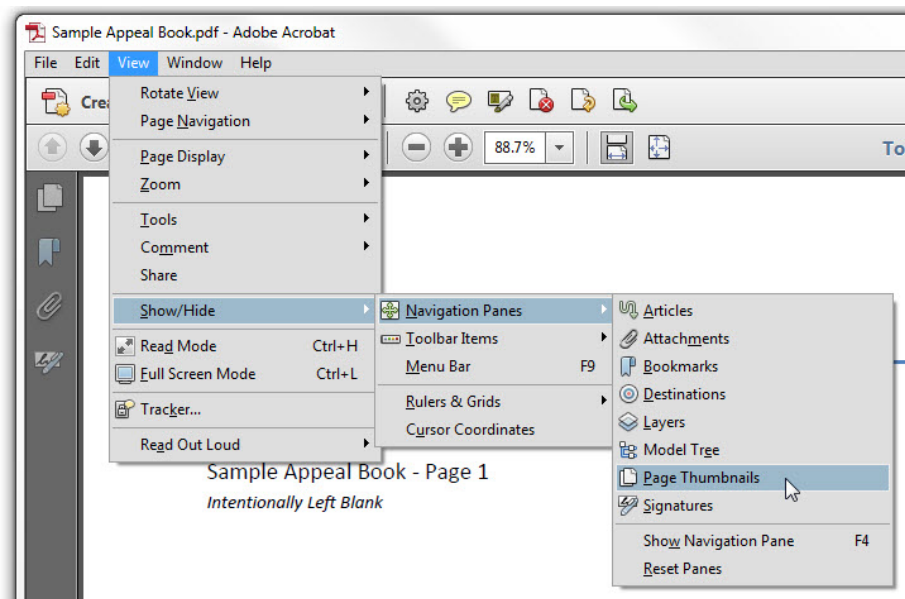


Set Title Page's Electronic Page Number to None

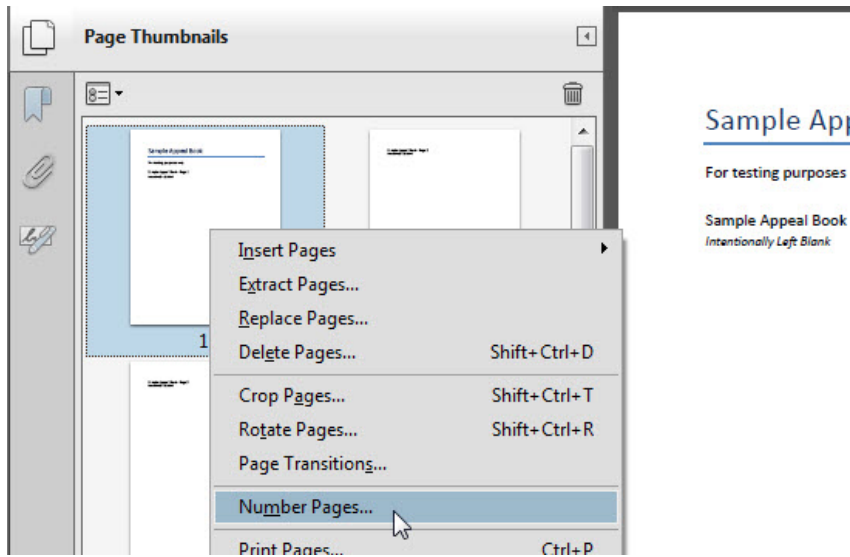
NOTE: There are several methods of changing page numbers in PDF files and this is just one of them. The instructions are intended only as a general description of the process. These instructions were prepared using Adobe Acrobat 9. Your procedure may vary depending on which PDF creation software you are using

The Number Pages command affect only the way page numbers are displayed in the title bar and on the page thumbnails. If you wish to physically add a page number to a PDF see our help document on Bates Stamping.

- 1) Open your PDF document in Adobe Acrobat.
- 2) Open the Pages Navigation Panel by selecting **View > Show/Hide > Navigation Panes > Page Thumbnails**.



- 3) **Right-click** on the thumbnail of the cover page and select **Number Pages...**



- 4) The **Page Numbering** dialogue box will appear. In the **Numbering** section select **None** from the **Style** dropdown. Press **OK**.
